NEW BUSINESS

Bylaws being proposed

- Chapter members must be dry beginning at 11:59 pm on the day before the start of Spirit Week until 12 pm the day after Bid Day.
- No chapter member is permitted to work in a bar during the week of recruitment beginning at 11:59 pm the day before UCF Day 1. During Spirit Week, chapter members are not allowed to work behind a bar
- With the exception of house checks, Potential New Members and Rho Gammas shall not enter any sorority house before a party has begun or after a party has ended, unless the chapters recruitment team is in accordance with it.
- PNMs will be lined up per the request of the individual chapter on their Panhellenic Recruitment Contract for that round of Primary Recruitment. In addition, Panhellenic will be prepared with attendance sheets that correlate to the line-up order requested by the chapter on their Panhellenic Recruitment Contract.
- PNMs will only be allowed to leave a party with the items they have entered with.
 - o a. To help lessen infractions chapters are NOT permitted to have napkins during recruitment with the exceptions of water bottles
- Verbal bids are defined as a sorority member stating or implying that she or her particular chapter is interested in recruiting a particular woman. Examples include "See you tomorrow" or "I could see you fitting in here".
- "During house tours, if a member and PNM are alone within a bedroom space but are continually moving throughout the bedroom space they are not in violation of an infraction. An infraction would be provided if they stopped/sat in the bedroom space where no other members and/or PNMs were located."
- Due to the difference in voting and list creation from organization to organization, additional time for list submission shall be provided. Lists should be due at the following times upon the completion of each round. Round 1 lists are due at 2 am, Round 2 lists are due at 2 am, Round 3 lists are due at 2 am, Round 4 lists are due at 3 am.
- "Chapters will turn in contracts electronically via email" to "chapters will submit list in person at The Office of Fraternity and Sorority Life."
