UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- These are the three recruitment rules we chose to table until next week! If you have any suggestions you can discuss them here so we are all on the same page and can propose changes next week!
- Section 3 Subsection 16 add "Due to the difference in voting and list creation from organization to organization, additional time for list submission shall be provided. Lists should be due at the following times upon the completion of each round. Round 1 lists are due at 2 am, Round 2 lists are due at 2 am, Round 3 lists are due at 2 am, Round 4 lists are due at 3 am."
 - Fabiola from Kappa Alpha Theta- Advisor suggested 4 hours after the last party has ended or do a general time (set number of hours) *individual chapter*
 - Fabiola has proposed to change that each individual chapter will have 4 hours after the party has ended to submit their list.
